## YAHOO! INC.'S WAIVER OF RIGHT TO REPLY

Pursuant to this Court's June 26, 2013 order Yahoo! Inc. ("Yahoo!"), waives its right to reply to the Government's June 25, 2013 response. The Government has informed Yahoo!, through its pleadings and otherwise, that Yahoo!'s name and Yahoo!'s counsels' identities are no longer classified and may be released immediately. Given that the Government has not objected to the relief Yahoo! has requested and has already declassified information about Yahoo! and its counsel's involvement in this case, Yahoo! waives its right to reply to the Government's June 25, 2013 response, and asks that this Court enter the relief requested in its motion. By doing so, Yahoo! does not waive any other rights it may have to challenge the Government's declassification decisions regarding the underlying order or other court records.
