This is an interim, supplemental response to the FOIA request at issue in the above-captioned litigation. As agreed upon pursuant to Joint Status Report dated May 3, 2019 (see ECF, Doc. No. 25) the FBI has performed searches reasonably likely to locate responsive records, in response to all four parts pf Plaintiff's FOIA request.

<u>Plaintiffs' FOIA request concerned four categories of information.</u> The results of the FBI's search and processing <u>efforts are as follows:</u>

- 1. "All internal memoranda or other documentation regarding the use of informants and/or CHSs at any Best Buy facility." The FBI performed searches to determine whether the agency has or had additional CHSs working at Best Buy facilities, apart from those acknowledged in the *Rettenmaier* litigation. As a result of those searches, the FBI acknowledges that it has located one or more records concerning one or more CHSs employed by one or more Best Buy facilities, apart from those acknowledged in the *Rettenmaier* litigation. The FBI has determined any information relating to such additional informant(s) is categorically exempt pursuant to FOIA Exemptions (b)(6), (b)(7)(C), (b)(7)(D) and (b)(7)(E). In addition, several of the additional informant records are separately categorically exempt pursuant to FOIA Exemptions (b)(1) and (b)(3). Finally, such records, or portions of those records are also exempt pursuant Exemptions (b)(1), and (b)(3), (b)(5), (b)(6), (b)(7)(C), (b)(7)(D), (b)(7)(E), and (b)(7)(F).
 - a. The FBI also located certain additional records pertaining to CHSs at Best Buy facilities, but which did not concern any informant(s) who had not previously been acknowledged in the *Rettenmaier* litigation. See EFF 244-247. Certain of these pages were withheld in full pursuant to coded categories as detailed in the attached Deleted Information Page Sheet ("DPIS"). See the enclosed Vaughn coding chart for explanations of the coded withholdings.
- "All internal memoranda or other documentation regarding FBI training of Best Buy personnel in the
 detection and location of child pornography, or other material, on computers brought to Best Buy for repair."
 The FBI located no documents responsive to this portion of Plaintiff's request.
- 3. "All recruiting material from the FBI directed to Best Buy personnel." The FBI located no documents responsive to this portion of Plaintiff's request.
- 4. "All memoranda, guidance, directives, or policy statements concerning the use of informants and/or CHSs at any computer repair facilities in the United States." The FBI requires additional time to respond to this portion of Plaintiffs' request.

In addition, the FBI has determined to release the name of the convicted individual on enclosed Bates pages EFF-13, 16-17, 19-20, 71-72, and 118 from the original production, and the re-processed pages are enclosed herein.

Finally, the FBI has processed for segregable release three of the informant files for the CHSs whose identities were disclosed during the *Rettenmaier* litigation. See enclosed Bates pages EFF 248-406 and 455-631. Certain of these pages were withheld in full pursuant to coded categories as detailed in the attached DPIS. See the enclosed Vaughn coding chart for explanations of the coded withholdings. The FBI requires additional time to respond to this portion of your request.

As noted above, the FBI requires additional time to respond to your FOIA request, and anticipates making a final production of any non-exempt, responsive documents on or before August 30, 2019.

FBI FOIPA Addendum

As referenced in our letter responding to your Freedom of Information/Privacy Acts (FOIPA) request, the FBI FOIPA Addendum includes information applicable to your request. Part 1 of the Addendum includes standard responses that apply to all requests. Part 2 includes additional standard responses that apply to all requests for records on individuals. Part 1: The standard responses below apply to all requests:

- (i) 5 U.S.C. § 552(c). Congress excluded three categories of law enforcement and national security records from the requirements of the FOIA [5 U.S.C. § 552(c) (2006 & Supp. IV (2010)]. FBI responses are limited to those records subject to the requirements of the FOIA. Additional information about the FBI and the FOIPA can be found on the www.fbi.gov/foia website.
- (ii) National Security/Intelligence Records. The FBI can neither confirm nor deny the existence of national security and foreign intelligence records pursuant to FOIA exemptions (b)(1), (b)(3), and PA exemption (j)(2) as applicable to requests for records about individuals [5 U.S.C. §§ 552/552a (b)(1), (b)(3), and (j)(2); 50 U.S.C. § 3024(i)(1)]. The mere acknowledgment of the existence or nonexistence of such records is itself a classified fact protected by FOIA exemption (b)(1) and/or would reveal intelligence sources, methods, or activities protected by exemption (b)(3) [50 USC.§ 3024(i)(1)]. This is a standard response and should not be read to indicate that national security or foreign intelligence records do or do not exist.

- (i) Requests for Records about any Individual—Watch Lists. The FBI can neither confirm nor deny the existence of any individual's name on a watch list pursuant to FOIA exemption (b)(7)(E) and PA exemption (j)(2) [5 U.S.C. §§ 552/552a (b)(7)(E), (j)(2)]. This is a standard response and should not be read to indicate that watch list records do or do not exist.
- (ii) Requests for Records for Incarcerated Individuals. The FBI can neither confirm nor deny the existence of records which could reasonably be expected to endanger the life or physical safety of any incarcerated individual pursuant to FOIA exemptions (b)(7)(E), (b)(7)(F), and PA exemption (j)(2) [5 U.S.C. §§ 552/552a (b)(7)(E), (b)(7)(F), and (j)(2)]. This is a standard response and should not be read to indicate that such records do or do not exist.

- (i) Record Searches. The Record/Information Dissemination Section (RIDS) searches for reasonably described records by searching those systems or locations where responsive records would reasonably be found. A reasonable search normally consists of a search for main files in the Central Records System (CRS), an extensive system of records consisting of applicant, investigative, intelligence, personnel, administrative, and general files compiled and maintained by the FBI in the course of fulfilling law enforcement, intelligence, and administrative functions. The CRS spans the entire FBI organization and encompasses the records of FBI Headquarters (FBIHQ), FBI Field Offices, and FBI Legal Attaché Offices (Legats) worldwide and includes Electronic Surveillance (ELSUR) records. - (ii) **FBI Records.** Founded in 1908, the FBI carries out a dual law enforcement and national security mission. As part of this dual mission, the FBI creates and maintains records on various subjects; however, the FBI does not maintain records on every person, subject, or entity.
- (iii) Requests for Criminal History Records or Rap Sheets. The Criminal Justice Information Services (CJIS) Division provides Identity History Summary Checks often referred to as a criminal history record or rap sheets. These criminal history records are not the same as material in an investigative "FBI file." An Identity History Summary Check is a listing of information taken from fingerprint cards and documents submitted to the FBI in connection with arrests, federal employment, naturalization, or military service. - (b)(1) (A) specifically authorized under criteria established by an Executive order to be kept secret in the interest of national defense or foreign policy and (B) are in fact properly classified to such Executive order;

- (b)(5) inter-agency or intra-agency memorandums or letters which would not be available by law to a party other than an agency in litigation with the agency;

- (b)(7) records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes, but only to the extent that the production of such law enforcement records or information (A) could reasonably be expected to interfere with enforcement proceedings, (B) would deprive a person of a right to a fair trial or an impartial adjudication, (C) could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, (D) could reasonably be expected to disclose the identity of confidential source, including a State, local, or foreign agency or authority or any private institution which furnished information on a confidential basis, and, in the case of record or information compiled by a criminal law enforcement authority in the course of a criminal investigation, or by an agency conducting a lawful national security intelligence investigation, information furnished by a confidential source, (E) would disclose techniques and procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions, or would disclose guidelines for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions if such disclosure could reasonably be expected to risk circumvention of the law, or (F) could reasonably be expected to endanger the life or physical safety of any individual;
- (b)(8) contained in or related to examination, operating, or condition reports prepared by, on behalf of, or for the use of an agency responsible for the regulation or supervision of financial institutions; or
- (b)(9) geological and geophysical information and data, including maps, concerning wells.

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Executive Summary

On 1/5/2012, FBI LS received information from a Best Buy employee that they received a hard drive for data recovery repair, and the hard drive contained child pornography (CP). FBI LS confirmed the images contained CP to include known victims, and seized the hard drive. The hard drive belonged to Mark Rettenmaeir, who resided in Laguna Hills, CA. On 1/18/2012, FBI LS sent a lead to FBI LA/Orange County RA (OCRA). On 1/23/2012, FBI LA/OCRA initiated investigation.

Recent Developments

 On 11/28/2017, Federal child pornography charges against Rettenmaeir were dropped by the US Attorney's Office, Central District of California (CDCA), as a result of the suppression of evidence that occurred in May 2017.

Background


- On 1/5/2012, FBI LS received information from a Best Buy employee that they received a hard drive for data recovery repair, and the hard drive contained child pornography (CP). The hard drive belonged to Mark Rettenmaeir, who resided in Laguna Hills, CA.
- On 1/18/2012, FBI LS sent a lead to FBI LA/Orange County RA.
- On 1/23/2012, FBI LA/OCRA initiated investigation.
- On 2/10/2012, FBI LA/OCRA received the hard drive containing CP from FBI LS. A search warrant was obtained for the hard drive.
- On 2/14/2012, FBI LA/OCRA executed a federal search warrant at Rettenmaeir's residence. Rettenmaeir was interviewed, but he retained an attorney and there were no admissions.
- A review of the digital evidence seized was conducted and numerous images of CP were found on Rettenmaeir's Apple laptop, two external hard drives, and an iPhone.
- On 11/12/2014, Rettenmaeir was indicted on two counts of possession of CP.
- On 5/15/2017, during a suppression hearing, the court denied the motion to suppress the evidence obtained as a result of Geek Squad's discovery of the illicit images, yet granted the motion to suppress the evidence obtained from the search of Rettenmaeir's house.
