1 **INTRODUCTION**

2 1. Since at least 2014, the Marin County Sheriff’s Office (the “Sheriff’s Office” or the
3 “Sheriff”) has shared and transferred the sensitive location information of its residents and the
4 people who travel through its boundaries with federal, state, and local agencies across the country,
5 including federal immigration agencies. The Sheriff collects this information using a system of
6 Automated License Plate Reader (“ALPR”) cameras, a surveillance technology that automatically
7 records the locations of cars and any visible drivers using cameras mounted on patrol cars, light
8 posts, or other infrastructure.

9 2. ALPR cameras can automatically scan and record the time-stamped locations of
10 thousands of drivers per day regardless of whether those drivers have violated any law.
11 Government agents use this location information to track people’s movements, habits, and
12 associations over time, including where a person lives, worships, and receives medical care. When
13 counties and municipalities like Marin County share and transfer this information to federal
14 immigration agencies, it is used to track, detain, and deport immigrants.

15 3. The Sheriff’s practice of sharing and transferring this personal information violates
16 state law in two ways. First, it violates a law known as Senate Bill 34 (“S.B. 34”), Cal. Civ. Code
17 §§ 1798.90.5 *et seq.*, which protects the privacy of all motorists by limiting how government
18 agencies may share their ALPR information. Second, it violates the California Values Act, Cal.
19 Gov’t Code §§ 7284 *et seq.*, which limits the use of state and local resources to assist federal
20 immigration enforcement.

21 4. The Sheriff’s sharing and transferring of sensitive personal information with
22 federal immigration agencies is consistent with the Sheriff’s long and troubling history of
23 targeting immigrant communities, including the Sheriff’s collaboration with Immigration and
24 Customs Enforcement (“ICE”) to transfer immigrant community members to ICE custody.

25 5. Plaintiffs Cesar Lagleva, Jr., Lisa Bennett, and Tara Evans are long-time members
26 of the Marin County community, as well as Marin County homeowners, business owners, and
27 taxpayers. They are committed advocates for immigrant justice, racial justice and equity, and the
28 human and civil rights of Marin County residents. They drive on a daily basis throughout Marin

1 County to work, drop off their children at school, meet friends and loved ones, volunteer, and
2 participate in myriad forms of civic and political life to advance their values.

3 6. The Sheriff collects massive amounts of location information of Plaintiffs and other
4 drivers who have no choice but to travel by car through Marin County on a regular basis. The
5 Sheriff then shares and transfers that sensitive personal information across the country to agencies
6 not subject to the important privacy protections imposed by the California legislature. The Sheriff
7 misappropriates and wastes taxpayer funds by spending those monies to share and transfer ALPR
8 information in violation of S.B. 34 and the California Values Act.

9 7. Plaintiffs seek to restrain and prevent the illegal expenditure of county funds and to
10 compel Defendants to comply with state law by ending the sharing and transferring of ALPR
11 information with out-of-state and federal entities. Plaintiffs also seek to stop the Sheriff from
12 sharing and transferring ALPR information to agencies the Sheriff knows or should know provide
13 this information to out-of-state or federal entities.

14 8. Plaintiffs seek declaratory, injunctive, and mandamus relief to end this harm.

15 **JURISDICTION AND VENUE**

16 9. This court has jurisdiction under Cal. Code Civ. Proc. §§ 410.10, 525, 526, 526a,
17 1060, and 1085.

18 10. Venue is proper in the Superior Court of Marin County under Cal. Code Civ. Proc.
19 §§ 393, 394, and 395 because Defendant Robert Doyle is a public officer being sued in his official
20 capacity for acts he performed as part of his public duties that have caused, and will cause, legal
21 injuries and deprivation of rights to persons in Marin County; this action is a proceeding against
22 Marin County; and all material actions and omissions occurred in Marin County.

23 **PARTIES**¹

24 **I. Plaintiffs**

25 11. Plaintiff Cesar Lagleva, Jr. is a long-time homeowner and taxpayer in Marin
26 County. An immigrant from the Philippines, Mr. Lagleva moved to the Canal neighborhood in San

1 Rafael, Marin County as a child. He attended and graduated from public schools in San Rafael.
2 After receiving his social-work degree, Mr. Lagleva entered a career in public service. He worked
3 for over twenty years in the Marin County Health and Human Services Department, including
4 many years with the Department's Behavioral Health and Recovery Services Division as a Mental
5 Health Practitioner. In that role, he worked with culturally and ethnically diverse juvenile-justice-
6 involved youth and their families. Mr. Lagleva has served as a commissioner on the Marin County
7 Human Rights Commission. He works as an educator and a consultant for immigrant-focused
8 programs. Mr. Lagleva has also engaged in a wide range of advocacy on behalf of the immigrant
9 communities in Marin County, including with non-profit organizations and grassroots groups. He
10 has received numerous awards recognizing his contributions to advancing the human and civil
11 rights of Marin communities. Mr. Lagleva has an interest in ensuring that drivers and immigrants
12 in Marin County are not harmed by Defendants' unlawful sharing and transferring of ALPR
13 information. Mr. Lagleva has been assessed and paid taxes that fund Defendants within the last
14 year, including sales and use taxes and property taxes.

15 12. Plaintiff Lisa Bennett is a homeowner in Marin County. She is an active member of
16 the civic landscape of Marin County. She has spoken at public forums held by the Marin County
17 Board of Supervisors to urge the County and the Sheriff to end practices that harm immigrants in
18 the community. Ms. Bennett has an interest in ensuring that drivers and immigrants in Marin
19 County are not harmed by Defendants' unlawful sharing and transferring of ALPR information.
20 Ms. Bennett has been assessed and paid taxes that fund Defendants within the last year, including
21 sales and use taxes and property taxes.

22 13. Plaintiff Tara Evans is a resident of Marin County. She attended and graduated
23 from public schools in Marin County and attended the College of Marin. She has served as the
24 Chair of the Stinson Beach Village Association. She is an active participant in numerous civic
25 activities, including advocacy to achieve equitable outcomes in Marin public schools and for West
26 Marin's significant Latinx population. Ms. Evans has an interest in ensuring that drivers and
27 immigrants in Marin County are not harmed by Defendants' unlawful sharing and transferring of
28

1 ALPR information. Ms. Evans has been assessed and paid taxes that fund Defendants within the
2 last year, including sales and use taxes and utility taxes.

3 **II. Defendants**

4 14. Defendant County of Marin is a political subdivision of the State of California. The
5 County of Marin funds and controls the operations of the Sheriff’s Office, including the
6 acquisition and use of an ALPR system.

7 15. Defendant Robert T. Doyle is the Marin County Sheriff and the head of the
8 Sheriff’s Office, which is the County’s principal law enforcement agency. Sheriff Doyle, the
9 Sheriff’s Office, and their agents control the acquisition, funding, and use of the ALPR system,
10 including the establishment and implementation of policies and practices relating to the ALPR
11 system and the sharing and transferring of ALPR information with agencies that are not “public
12 agencies” as defined by S.B. 34, including out-of-state and federal agencies. Sheriff Doyle is sued
13 in his official capacity.

14 **STATEMENT OF FACTS**

15 **I. Automated License Plate Readers Are An Invasive Mass Surveillance Technology.**

16 16. Automated license plate readers are a mass-surveillance technology.

17 17. ALPR cameras automatically capture color images of license plates of drivers that
18 pass within their field of view, even though the overwhelming majority of drivers have not
19 violated any law. Fixed cameras are mounted on stationary objects or infrastructure, such as light
20 poles or overpasses, while mobile cameras are mounted on moving objects, such as patrol cars.

21 18. Software extracts the license plate numbers from the images and stores the images,
22 license plate numbers, and precise dates, times, and Global Positioning System (“GPS”)
23 coordinates of the image captures in a searchable database. Although the primary focus of each
24 image is the license plate, the image may also show part of the vehicle itself, including individuals
25 within the vehicle, depending on the camera’s position. The photograph, plate number, GPS
26 location coordinates, and date and time information are collectively referred to herein as “ALPR
27 information.”
28

1 19. An ALPR system consists of the cameras, the software that reads and converts
2 images of license plates into data, and the searchable database that stores the data.

3 20. Government agents can easily search the databases storing ALPR information.
4 They may search for a full license plate number to locate a specific vehicle, search for a partial
5 license plate number to locate a group of vehicles, or search for all vehicles recorded in
6 geographic area at specific times. In addition, after the ALPR system identifies a license plate
7 number in an image, it compares the plate number to stored lists of license plate numbers from
8 vehicles of interest, called “hot lists,” and notifies the agency that listed the vehicle of a match,
9 called a “hit.”

10 21. A single ALPR camera can capture the locations of thousands of drivers in a short
11 time, all without any human involvement. For example, the Sacramento County Sheriff once
12 captured 1.7 million plates in one week, according to a 2020 California State Auditor report.

13 22. ALPR systems radically decrease the personnel and equipment costs necessary for
14 government authorities to effortlessly surveil drivers *en masse*, removing a traditional check on
15 government power by permitting the dragnet and continuous surveillance of entire communities in
16 a manner that did not exist before the invention of modern surveillance systems. By tracking and
17 recording where people are across time, ALPR information can reveal a person’s private habits,
18 movements, and associations.

19 23. A person who regularly drives through an area subject to ALPR surveillance can
20 have their location information captured multiple times per day. This information can provide an
21 intimate window into a person’s life as they travel from home to work, drop off their children at
22 school, or park at a house of worship, a doctor’s office, or a protest.

23 24. Location information revealing people’s physical movements, even in public
24 spaces, enjoy constitutional protection under the Fourth Amendment. That protection exists
25 because the recording of individual movements over time reveals sensitive information about a
26 person’s private life. The U.S. Supreme Court has held that “[a] person does not surrender all
27 [privacy] protections by venturing into the public sphere,” recognizing that modern location
28 tracking allows the Government to “travel back in time to retrace a person’s whereabouts,”

1 impacting everyone, not only “persons who might happen to come under investigation.”
2 *Carpenter v. U.S.*, 138 S. Ct. 2206, 2217-18 (2018).

3 25. Short of choosing not to drive, there is no way for a person traveling within Marin
4 County to avoid having their location information captured by the Sheriff’s ALPR surveillance
5 system. Yet many Marin County residents have no choice but to drive because Marin County is a
6 car-dependent series of communities spread across 828 square miles and varied topographies.

7 26. In addition to collecting information on the population at large, governments have
8 long used surveillance—ranging from wiretaps to social media monitoring—to target individuals
9 from disfavored and marginalized groups based on, among other attributes, their race, national
10 origin, ethnicity, religion, socioeconomic status, sexuality, gender identity, and political activism.
11 ALPR systems are no exception to this history.

12 27. For example, the Oakland Police Department has deployed ALPRs
13 “disproportionately often in low-income areas and in neighborhoods with high concentrations of
14 African-American and Latino residents.”²

15 28. Likewise, the New York Police Department targeted Muslim Americans by driving
16 ALPRs past parking areas next to mosques.³

17 29. Given the sensitivity of the location information collected, and the ability to use
18 ALPR information to target and locate individuals, the Sheriff’s widespread sharing and
19 transferring of ALPR information with federal and out-of-state agencies poses serious threats to
20 communities’ privacy and freedom of movement.

21 30. Specifically, the Sheriff’s Office shares and transfers ALPR information with ICE,
22 Customs and Border Protection (“CBP”), 18 other federal agencies, and 424 out-of-state law
23 enforcement agencies.

1 31. Like many law enforcement agencies across the country, the Sheriff’s Office uses a
2 software and database called LEARN, created and operated by a company called Vigilant
3 Solutions, in order to share and transfer ALPR information, including with federal and out-of-state
4 agencies.

5 32. Federal immigration agencies use the ALPR information shared with them by the
6 Sheriff’s Office and other law enforcement agencies to locate, detain, and deport immigrants.

7 33. Since at least 2019, ICE has received ALPR information shared and transferred by
8 local agencies via the LEARN nationwide database. Local law enforcement agencies can share
9 with ICE, through the LEARN nationwide database, the location of hundreds of millions of scans
10 of vehicle license plates that their ALPR cameras have captured.

11 34. ICE has conducted thousands of searches of the ALPR information shared with and
12 transferred to it via the LEARN nationwide database. In a several-month period in 2018, ICE
13 performed over 30,000 searches per month of the ALPR information shared via the database.⁴
14 Through its searches, ICE has tracked individuals to arrest them for alleged violations of
15 immigration law, such as overstaying visas or working without authorization. ICE’s records
16 indicate that ICE officers have searched the LEARN database to conduct surveillance of family
17 members—with no apparent protections to ensure that U.S. citizens are not ensnared—in
18 order to arrest and deport immigrants. ICE has also requested and received ALPR information
19 by email from local law enforcement agencies, circumventing any limitations contained in the
20 LEARN nationwide database on the sharing and transferring of ALPR information.⁵

21 35. CBP has also used ALPR information shared and transferred to it by local agencies
22 and private actors through the LEARN nationwide database.⁶ CBP’s use of this surveillance

1 technology is deeply troubling, given CBP’s long and well-documented history of violence against
2 immigrants, profiling and expulsion of people seeking humanitarian relief, and surveillance and
3 retaliation against immigration attorneys and activists.⁷ Further, CBP’s overreach to engage in
4 domestic surveillance and policing—outside the bounds of its stated mission to safeguard U.S.
5 borders—is well-documented.⁸

6 36. Considering such abuses by ICE and CBP, the Sheriff’s rampant sharing of ALPR
7 information with these agencies (and many other non-California agencies) harms the well-being
8 and safety of local community members, needlessly subjecting them to law enforcement scrutiny
9 and abuse in violation of state law.

10 **II. Two California Statutes Limit the Sharing and Transferring of ALPR Information.**

11 37. S.B. 34 addresses serious harms caused by this mass surveillance system. It also
12 exemplifies how the California legislature can exercise its authority over in-state law enforcement
13 agencies to impose critical safeguards and limitations. The law imposes clear requirements upon
14 public agencies using and operating ALPR systems to prevent the mishandling and abuse of
15 ALPR information, secure the right of the public to conduct oversight of ALPR system use, and
16 ensure that access to ALPR information is justified, tracked, audited, and limited. Consistent with
17 its focus on maintaining security, limited access, and privacy, S.B. 34 prohibits the sharing and

1 transferring of ALPR information with any agencies other than in-state agencies. S.B. 34 also
2 requires California law enforcement agencies using ALPR systems to adopt usage and privacy
3 policies, create reasonable security safeguards, and implement a system for auditing and limiting
4 access to ALPR information.

5 38. The California Values Act, S.B. 54, recognizes the danger to the public and its
6 safety when local law enforcement agencies entangle themselves with federal immigration
7 authorities. To protect the safety, well-being, and constitutional rights of the people of California,
8 the Legislature prohibited local law enforcement agencies from using personnel or funds for
9 immigration enforcement purposes, including the sharing of personal information. This includes
10 ALPR information.

11 **III. The Sheriff Collects ALPR information on Thousands of Marin County Drivers.**

12 39. Marin County and the Sheriff's Office first purchased ALPR technology in 2010.

13 40. The Sheriff currently operates an ALPR system consisting of ALPR cameras and
14 LEARN software and database purchased and licensed from Vigilant Solutions.

15 41. The Sheriff currently operates twelve ALPR cameras. Eight of these cameras are
16 assigned to its patrol division and four cameras are assigned to the auto theft division.

17 42. Using these ALPR cameras, the Sheriff collects vast quantities of information
18 about Marin County residents and people who travel through its boundaries.

19 43. In 2018, the Sheriff used the ALPR system to record 678,936 scans of driver
20 license plates and location information

21 44. In 2019, the Sheriff used the ALPR system to record 868,218 scans of driver
22 license plates and location information.

23 45. In 2020, the Sheriff used the ALPR system to record 821,244 scans of driver
24 license plates and location information.

25 46. Despite the hundreds of thousands of pieces of location information collected, only
26 a sliver of the license plates captured by the Sheriff are "hits," or plates that are of interest.

27 47. In 2018, there were only 193 hits for 678,936 scans, meaning the ALPR system
28 detected a match for only 0.02% of scans conducted that year.

1 48. In 2019, there were only 364 hits for 868,218 scans, meaning the ALPR system
2 detected a match for only 0.04% of scans conducted that year.

3 49. In 2020, there were only 216 hits for 821,244 scans, meaning the ALPR system
4 detected a match for only 0.02% of scans conducted that year.

5 **IV. Marin County and the Sheriff Expend Taxpayer Funds To Share and Transfer**
6 **ALPR Information with Out-of-State and Federal Agencies.**

7 50. For many years, the Sheriff and his agents have shared and transferred ALPR
8 information that they collect through the ALPR system with out-of-state and federal government
9 agencies, including ICE and CBP.

10 51. The Sheriff and his agents use a software and database called LEARN to store,
11 search, and share and transfer ALPR information with those outside agencies. LEARN provides a
12 user interface to search license plates and the option to share ALPR information and “hot lists”
13 with other agencies through the database.

14 52. The Sheriff stores ALPR information on the LEARN database, which is a cloud
15 service, and shares ALPR information with other agencies that are users of LEARN.

16 53. Using the LEARN software, the Sheriff and his agents select and designate out-of-
17 state and federal agencies as “sharing partners.”

18 54. The Sheriff and his agents share and transfer ALPR information to the agencies
19 they select as “sharing partners” by allowing the “sharing partners” to search for a license plate
20 number among the ALPR information collected by the Sheriff. If that license plate number has
21 been captured by the Sheriff’s ALPR system, the Sheriff transfers, through LEARN and the ALPR
22 system, the ALPR information associated with that matched license plate to the sharing partner
23 agency. The Sheriff transfers not only a photograph of the license plate and surrounding area, but
24 also the date, time, and location coordinates.

25 55. In addition to the method of sharing and transferring described above, the Sheriff
26 shares and transfers ALPR information to other agencies by allowing those agencies to compare
27 their own bulk lists of vehicle license plates of interest, known as “hot lists,” against the ALPR
28 information collected by the Sheriff.

1 56. If the Sheriff’s ALPR cameras scan and capture a license plate that is on the “hot
2 list” of one of these other agencies, the Sheriff’s ALPR system transfers the ALPR information
3 associated with that hit to the other agency.

4 57. The Sheriff can generate a “sharing report” from the ALPR system and LEARN
5 software.

6 58. The “sharing report” is a list of the “sharing partner” agencies, including out-of-
7 state and federal agencies, with whom the Sheriff shares and transfers ALPR information. The
8 “sharing report” also lists the agencies whose “hot lists” the Sheriff and his agents have selected to
9 run against the ALPR information collected by the Sheriff.

10 59. The Sheriff has consistently shared and transferred ALPR information with federal
11 immigration agencies.

12 60. In 2014, an administrator for the Sheriff’s ALPR system shared ALPR information
13 collected by the system with three ICE sub-components, according to a 2020 report by the
14 California State Auditor. That same report noted that the Sheriff was sharing and transferring
15 ALPR information to the San Diego Sector of the U.S. Border Patrol (a sub-component of CBP)
16 when the California State Auditor began its audit.

17 61. In 2021, a “sharing report” produced by the Sheriff lists 424 out-of-state agencies
18 and 18 federal agencies, including two sub-components of CBP and ICE.⁹

19 62. As reflected in the “sharing report,” the Sheriff shares and transfers ALPR
20 information with at least 18 federal agencies. Two of these agencies support the federal
21 government’s immigration enforcement apparatus: CBP’s National Targeting Center, and ICE’s
22 Homeland Security Investigations Bulk Cash Smuggling Center. The other federal agencies
23 include the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Forest Service, the Drug Enforcement Agency,
24 and the Postal Inspection Service.

25 63. As reflected in the “sharing report,” the Sheriff also shares and transfers ALPR
26 information with at least 424 out-of-state agencies. This includes law enforcement agencies
27

1 located as far afield as Enfield, Connecticut; St. Louis, Missouri; Lafayette, Louisiana; and
2 Newton County, Georgia.

3 64. As reflected in the “sharing report,” the Sheriff shares and transfers ALPR
4 information with a “fusion center,” the Northern California Regional Intelligence Center
5 (“NCRIC”).

6 65. NCRIC’s stated purpose is to share information and “facilitate communication
7 between federal, state, local, tribal and territorial public safety agencies,” according to the Center’s
8 public website.¹⁰

9 66. The Sheriff’s sharing of ALPR information with NCRIC allows numerous other
10 federal agencies not listed on the Sheriff’s “sharing report” to receive ALPR information collected
11 by the Sheriff and to track Marin County drivers as a result.

12 67. None of the 18 federal agencies or 424 out-of-state agencies are subject to the
13 aforementioned strict ALPR monitoring, tracking, auditing, and sharing limitations imposed by
14 the Legislature on California law enforcement agencies.

15 68. The Sheriff’s sharing and transferring of ALPR information to hundreds of non-
16 California agencies—and the thousands of officers they employ—means that the sensitive
17 personal information of Marin drivers is being exploited for reasons unknown to Marin drivers or
18 the Sheriff.

19 69. The Sheriff’s sharing and transferring of ALPR information facilitates the location
20 tracking of residents and visitors of Marin County, including immigrants, activists, and other
21 people not suspected of any violation of the law.

22 70. The County and the Sheriff expend taxpayer funds, personnel time, and resources
23 to purchase and operate the ALPR system, including but not limited to purchasing and licensing
24 ALPR cameras and the LEARN software and database; training the Sheriff’s agents on the use of
25 the ALPR system; operating, managing, and maintaining the ALPR system; selecting and

1 designating out-of-state and federal agencies as “sharing partners”; and sharing and transferring
2 ALPR information with out-of-state and federal agencies.

3 71. Absent an order from this Court, the County and the Sheriff will continue to expend
4 taxpayer funds, personnel time, and resources on this ALPR system, including on the sharing and
5 transfer of ALPR information with out-of-state and federal agencies.

6 72. Plaintiffs tried to resolve this matter by sending a letter to Sheriff Doyle. But
7 Sheriff Doyle has not responded to Plaintiffs’ demand that he cease the unlawful conduct
8 described in this complaint.

9 **CAUSES OF ACTION**

10 **First Cause of Action**
11 **Violation of Cal. Civ. Code §§ 1798.90.5 *et seq.***
12 **(All Plaintiffs Against All Defendants)**

13 73. Plaintiffs re-allege and incorporate by reference each of the allegations above as if
14 fully set forth herein.

15 74. S.B. 34 explicitly prohibits public agencies from selling, sharing, or transferring
16 ALPR information except to another public agency, as defined by S.B. 34, and only as otherwise
17 authorized by law. Cal. Civ. Code §§ 1798.90.5 *et seq.*

18 75. The County and Sheriff violate S.B. 34 by sharing and transferring ALPR
19 information to entities that are not “public agencies” as defined by S.B. 34, including to out-of-
20 state and federal agencies.

21 76. The County and Sheriff violate S.B. 34 by sharing and transferring ALPR
22 information to agencies that they know or should know share or transfer ALPR information to
23 entities that are not “public agencies” as defined by S.B. 34, including to out-of-state and federal
24 agencies.

25 **Second Cause of Action**
26 **Violation of Cal. Gov’t Code §§ 7284 *et seq.***
27 **(All Plaintiffs Against All Defendants)**

28 77. Plaintiffs re-allege and incorporate by reference each of the allegations above as if
fully set forth herein.

1 78. The California Values Act limits state and local agencies from using moneys or
2 personnel to investigate or detect persons for immigration enforcement purposes. Cal. Gov't Code
3 § 7284 *et seq.* Among its provisions, the California Values Act bars sharing of personal
4 information to federal immigration enforcement agencies for immigration enforcement. *Id.*
5 § 7284(a)(1)(D).

6 79. ALPR information constitutes "personal information."

7 80. The County and Sheriff violate the California Values Act by using department
8 moneys and personnel to share ALPR information with agencies engaged in the enforcement of
9 immigration law.

10 **Third Cause of Action**
11 **Taxpayer Action under Cal. Code of Civ. Proc.**
12 **§ 526a to Prevent Illegal Expenditure of Funds**
 (All Plaintiffs Against All Defendants)

13 81. Plaintiffs re-allege and incorporate by reference each of the allegations above as if
14 fully set forth herein.

15 82. The County and Sheriff are and will continue to be illegally expending public funds
16 by (a) sharing and transferring ALPR information to entities that are not "public agencies" as
17 defined by S.B. 34, including to out-of-state and federal agencies, in violation of Civ. Code
18 §§ 1798.90.5 *et seq.* and Gov't Code §§ 7284 *et seq.*; (b) sharing and transferring ALPR
19 information to entities that they know or should know share or transfer ALPR information to
20 entities that are not "public agencies" as defined by S.B. 34, including to out-of-state and federal
21 agencies, in violation of Civ. Code §§ 1798.90.5 *et seq.* and Gov't Code §§ 7284 *et seq.*; and
22 (c) providing ALPR information with agencies engaged in the enforcement of immigration law in
23 violation of these same provisions.

24 83. Plaintiffs are all taxpayers within the meaning of Cal. Code Civ. Proc. § 526a, and
25 have been, and continue to be, injured by the County and Sheriff's use of their taxpayer funds on
26 the illegal sharing and transferring of ALPR information.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

- 1
- 2 84. Plaintiffs respectfully request this Court grant the following relief:
- 3 a. A declaration that Defendants’ sharing and transferring of ALPR information to
- 4 entities that are not “public agencies” as defined by S.B. 34, including to out-of-
- 5 state and federal agencies, violates S.B. 34;
- 6 b. A declaration that Defendants’ sharing and transferring of ALPR information to
- 7 federal immigration agencies violates the California Values Act;
- 8 c. A writ of mandate and injunction prohibiting Defendants from sharing or
- 9 transferring ALPR information to entities that are not “public agencies” as defined
- 10 by S.B. 34, including to out-of-state and federal agencies; from sharing or
- 11 transferring ALPR information to entities that Defendants know or should know
- 12 share or transfer ALPR information to entities that are not “public agencies” as
- 13 defined by S.B. 34, including to out-of-state or federal agencies; or expending
- 14 funds, resources, or employee time to do so, in compliance with S.B. 34;
- 15 d. A writ of mandate and injunction prohibiting Defendants from sharing or
- 16 transferring ALPR information to federal immigration agencies, or expending
- 17 funds, resources, or employee time to do so, in compliance with the California
- 18 Values Act;
- 19 e. That all of these injunctive and mandamus orders bind Defendants’ agents and
- 20 those working in concert with them;
- 21 f. Reasonable attorneys’ fees and costs pursuant to Cal. Code Civ. Proc.
- 22 §§ 1021, 1021.5, and any other applicable law; and
- 23 g. All other relief the Court deems just and proper.
