belief about the truth of the allegations set forth in Paragraph 230 of the Complaint and therefore

denies the same.

The Court has dismissed the ATS claim, and therefore no response is required. To

the extent a response is required, DarkMatter denies the allegations set forth in the first two

sentences of Paragraph 231 of the Complaint. DarkMatter lacks knowledge or information

sufficient to form a belief about the truth of the allegations set forth in the third sentence of

Paragraph 231 of the Complaint and therefore denies the same.

232. The Court has dismissed the ATS claim, and therefore no response is required. To

the extent a response is required, DarkMatter lacks knowledge or information sufficient to form a

belief about the truth of the allegations set forth in Paragraph 232 of the Complaint and therefore

denies the same.

233. The Court has dismissed the ATS claim, and therefore no response is required. To

the extent a response is required, DarkMatter denies the allegations set forth in Paragraph 233 of

the Complaint.

234. The Court has dismissed the ATS claim, and therefore no response is required.

Paragraph 234 also contains legal conclusions to which no response is required. To the extent a

response is required, DarkMatter denies the allegations in paragraph 234.

The unnumbered Paragraphs following Paragraph 234 consist of Plaintiff's prayer for relief

and jury trial demand to which no response is required. To the extent a response is required,

DarkMatter denies that Plaintiff is entitled to the requested relief or any relief whatsoever.

AFFIRMATIVE AND OTHER DEFENSES

Without conceding that DarkMatter has the burden of proof or persuasion as to any of

Plaintiff's claims, DarkMatter states as follows:

FIRST DEFENSE

(No Injury)

Plaintiff has not sustained loss or damages caused by any conduct by DarkMatter.

SECOND DEFENSE

(Statute of Limitations)

Insofar as Plaintiff's claims arose outside the applicable limitations period, those claims

are time-barred.

THIRD DEFENSE

(No Causation)

DarkMatter denies that Plaintiff has suffered damages, but to the extent damages have been incurred, such damages were not directly or proximately caused by DarkMatter.

FOURTH DEFENSE

(Personal Jurisdiction)

The Court lacks personal jurisdiction over DarkMatter.

FIFTH DEFENSE

(Laches)

All of Plaintiff's claims are barred by the doctrine of laches.

SIXTH DEFENSE

(Venue)

Plaintiff failed to bring this case in a proper venue, based on its shift with respect to the acts it alleges constituted violations.

SEVENTH DEFENSE

DarkMatter had nothing to do with, nor did it have knowledge of, any operations of the UAE government that involved Plaintiff. DarkMatter seconded employees to the UAE government as a government contractor of the UAE.

EIGHTH DEFENSE

DarkMatter acted as an agent of the UAE and is entitled to common law conduct-based immunity.

RESERVATION OF RIGHTS

DarkMatter reserves the right to assert additional affirmative defenses or defenses of which it becomes knowledgeable during the course of this litigation.

WHEREFORE, DarkMatter prays for judgment as follows:

- 1. That Plaintiff is denied the requested relief and that the same be dismissed with prejudice;
 - 2. That judgment be entered for DarkMatter;
- 3. That DarkMatter recover the costs of suit herein, including attorneys' fees as allowed by law; and
 - 4. That DarkMatter be granted such further relief as the Court deems just and proper. Dated this 1st day of October, 2025.
