In this regard, in in conjunction with an on-going international terrorism investigation of Division personnel prepared and issued requests for hotel records pertaining to the subject and his companion, and financial records pertaining to the subject. The latter request was sent by facsimile within hours of the attacks on the World Trade Center and the Pentagon to requesting bank and credit card records.
