 - d) A Point of Contact, for each database listed, who would be able to discuss the database and access.
 Please include title and phone number with the POC's name.
- 2. Does your office utilize databases to house information derived from NSLs, such as analyses, comments, case information? If yes please provide the following information:
 - a) A listing of the databases.
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 - c) Other agencies, including Federal, State, local and private-sector entities, who have access to the database.
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

Title: REQUEST FOR DOCUMENTS IN RESPONSE TO THE OFFICE OF THE INSPECTOR GENERAL'S (OIG) TO REVIEW THE FBI'S USE OF NATIONAL SECURITY LETTERS (NSLS) AND BUSINESS RECORD REQUESTS; OIG PATRIOT ACT REVIEW

Synopsis: The OIG has requested documents from the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) to facilitate their review of the FBI's utilization of certain authorities established or expanded pursuant to the USA PATRIOT Act, Public Law 107-56, as amended (Patriot Act).

Details: The Special Requests Response Unit (SRRU), Inspection Division (INSD), has received various document and information requests from the OIG related to their review of the FBI's utilization of certain authorities established or expanded pursuant to the Patriot Act. On December 12, 2005, the OIG requested certain detailed information be provided by the FBI. In an effort to fully comply, Headquarters Divisions are requested to submit all responsive documents based on the criteria outlined below:

(a) NSLs Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. §2709 (a), as Amended, to Obtain Access to Certain Communication Service Provider Records;

(b) NSLs Pursuant to \$1114 (A) (5) (A) of the Right to Financial Privacy Act (12 U.S.C. 3414 (A) (5) (A), as Amended) to Obtain Financial Institution Customer Records;

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(c) NSLs Pursuant to §802 of the National Security Act of 1947 (50 U.S.C. §436, as Amended) to Obtain Access to Financial Information, Records, and Consumer Reports; and

(d) NSLs Pursuant to §§626 and 627 of the Fair Credit Reporting Act (15 U.S.C. §§ 1681u and 1681v, as Amended) to Obtain Access to Financial Information, Consumer Reports and Credit Agency Consumer Records.

For NSLs obtained as described by (a) through (d), provide any **reports**, **studies**, **evaluations**, **analyses**, **or surveys** created by the FBI or on its behalf evaluating the effectiveness of NSLs as an investigative tool, including data or evaluations of the following:

(1) the importance of the information acquired by the Department of Justice to the intelligence activities of the Department of Justice or to any other department or agency of the Federal Government;

(2) the manner in which information acquired is collected, retained, analyzed, and disseminated by the Department of Justice including any access to this information, including "raw take" or "raw data," provided to any other Department, agency, or instrumentality of Federal, State, local, or tribal governments, or to any private sector entity;

(3) whether and how often the Department of Justice utilized acquired information to produce an analytical intelligence product for distribution within the Department of Justice, to the intelligence community, or to other Federal, state, local, or tribal government Departments, agencies, or instrumentalities; and

(4) whether and how often the Department of Justice provided acquired information to law enforcement authorities for use in criminal proceedings (providing investigative case numbers and contact information in each instance).

Provide responsive documents for calendar years 2003, 2004, and 2005. Please respond separately for each calendar year.

Please submit your response, either in the negative or by providing responsive material, to the Special Requests Response Unit, Inspection Division, on or before Wednesday, June 28, 2006. Documents should be submitted to SRRU. FBIHQ, Room 1B224, Attention: Acting Unit Chief


Not sure how much you will be involved with the NSL issue, but and agent who used to work for me sent an e-mail below that is interesting and could be helpful.
