Smith v. Maryland, 442 U.S. 735, 742-43 (1979) (internal quotations and citations omitted). Moreover, in Smith, the Court stated that it "consistently has held that a person has no legitimate expectation of privacy in information he voluntarily turns over to third parties." Id. at 743-44. See also Katz v. United States, 389 U.S. 347, 361 (1967) (holding that this expectation is not "one that society is prepared to recognize as 'reasonable.").
In the Post article, the author minimizes the comparison of NSLs to grand jury subpoenas because subpoenas are backward looking and at least have a prosecutor's review. The article also complains that NSLs have no independent judicial review.
Section 3122 "was not intended to require independent judicial review of relevance; rather, the reviewing court need only verify the completeness of the certification." In re United States, 10 F.3d 931, 935 (2nd Cir. 1993) (citing S. Rep. No. 541, 99th Cong., 2d Sess. 47 (1986), reprinted in 1986 U.S. Code Cong.& Admin. News 3555, 3601), cert. denied, 513 U.S. 812 (1994); see also United States v. Fregoso, 60 F.3d 1314, 1320 (8th Cir. 1995) (holding that the judicial role under Section 3123(a) is ministerial in nature because a proper application under Section 3122 mandates entry of the order).



Under ECPA, the person whose toll billing records were sought had to be a foreign power or agent of a foreign power (AFP) as defined in FISA. This means that for a US Person (USP), there did need to be suspicious conduct, inasmuch as a USP AFP is defined to require that the person is involved in clandestine intelligence activities that may involve a violation of US criminal statutes (50 USC 1801(b)(2)(A), (B)); engaged in sabotage or international terrorism (1801(b)(2)(C); had entered US fraudulently for or on behalf of a foreign power (1801(b)(2) (D); or aiding and betting persons described above (1801(b)(2)(E). For the second subset of the definition of non-USP AFP, 50 USC 1801(b)(1)(B), there was also "individualized suspicion" involved, inasmuch as it includes persons engaged in or aiding persons engaged in clandestine intelligence activities contrary to the interests of the US on behalf of a foreign power. Under ECPA, the telephone for which subscriber information was sought had to have been in communication with persons engaged in international terrorism or clandestine intelligence activities that may involve a criminal law violation or had been in communication with an agent of a foreign power wherein the communication concerned international terrorism or clandestine intelligence activities that may involve a criminal law violation. Under the FCRA, the person whose financial institution information was sought had to be a foreign power or a non-USP official of a foreign power or an agent of a foreign power engaged in international terrorism or clandestine intelligence activities that may involve a criminal law violation. Under the FCRA, the person about whom identifying information was sought needed to be in contact with a foreign power or agent of a foreign power, as defined in FISA.
