

I understand that you cannot comment on the specifics of this case, but would you please detail what internal guidelines the Bureau has in place to ensure that this investigative power is used only when absolutely passesses." when absolutely necessary?

Response:

The press reports concerning the National Security Letter (NSL) referenced in this question were not entirely accurate. Although many of the facts surrounding that NSL are classified and consequently cannot be discussed in this unclassified response, we can clarify that the NSL was served under 18 U.S.C. § 2709. This section of the Electronic Communications Privacy Act permits the FBI to obtain electronic communications records, not library lending records. It should also be noted that the NSL served in that case, which was based entirely on pre-PATRIOT Act authorities issued pursuant to statutory authority first granted to the FBI in 1986, has been the subject of extensive litigation in the District of Connecticut and the United States Court of

DOJRequestsforRevisionQFRResponses-1.txt Appeals for the Second Circuit. In her ruling on 9/9/05, District Court Judge Janet C. Hall specifically found: "In this instance . . . the investigation clearly relates to national security. The government has a legitimate interest and duty in undertaking an investigation that includes this NSL. Further, it is clear to the court that the NSL was not issued solely on the basis of First Amendment activities."

The FBI's national security investigations are conducted pursuant to the Attorney General's 10/31/03 Guidelines for FBI National Security Investigations and Foreign Intelligence Collection (NSIG). Those Guidelines were designed to ensure the privacy of law-abiding Americans while permitting the FBI to use lawful investigative techniques to protect the United States from threats to the national security. All FBI investigative activities must be consistent with the U.S. Constitution and all applicable statutes, executive orders, and regulations.

The NSIG authorizes three levels of FBI investigative activity (threat assessments, preliminary investigations, and full investigations) and provides clear and concise predicates required for each level of investigative activity. Those specific predicates are articulated in classified portions of the NSIG because they relate to intelligence activities, sources, or methods. While NSLs are an important tool in FBI national security investigations, safeguards protect against the potential abuse of investigative techniques, including NSLs. NSLs are an important tool in FBI national security investigations and are accompanied by significant safeguards. The FBI's Office of the General Counsel has issued FBI-wide guidance to explain the standards, procedures, and forms for issuing NSLs. That guidance makes it clear that NSLs may be issued only when the information sought is relevant to a national security investigation and that NSLs may not be used in investigations that are unrelated to international terrorism or clandestine intelligence activities. Moreover, NSLs are only available to request narrow categories of records from a limited set of institutions, such as electronic communications records from electronic communications providers. An NSL must be approved by a senior FBI official; this person is always an SES official and is typically a field office SAC.

Finally, the FBI is subject to DOJ and Congressional oversight. For example, all of the FBI's terrorism-related cases are subject to in-progress review by DOJ's Office of Intelligence Policy and Review. In addition, the FBI tracks and reports to Congress semiannually the total number of NSLs issued by the FBI. The FBI also tracks its NSL use and is subject to statutory reporting requirements.



(U) The Patriot Act altered the standard necessary to obtain a national security letter ("NSL"). Prior to those amendments, the FBI could issue an NSL only if, as a general matter, there were specific and articulable facts that the person to whom the records relate was a foreign power or an agent of a foreign power. Put differently, the FBI had to have reached a defensible position that the person was a terrorist or spy before we could gather the basic information we would need to determine whether the person was a terrorist or spy. In addition, OGC revised the standard form for investigators to use in issuing NSLs. The result was a large increase in the number of NSLs issued by the FBI to further its investigations.
