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All,

I attended a meeting along with [redacted] (FBI) and [redacted] to discuss moving the [redacted] from
it's present location [redacted] to a new location [redacted]. Also discussed the procurement of a new Red Wolf vs.
VoiceBox collection system.

I was advised by [redacted] that the trailers [redacted] are to be dismantled within the next few months due to
mold and leaking issues. I was informed that a building [redacted] has been identified as a
suitable location to move our collection system into. I was advised that a site survey would likely need to be completed
within the next couple of weeks. [redacted] to decide wether to involve the fascilities group or not) I would prefer [redacted]
[redacted] or one of his folks to do a site survey along with myself.

I explained that depending on what system they procure would dictate our HVAC and Power requirements. I explained that we would prefer (1 [redacted])

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[redacted] suggested having all the infrastructure in place prior to any movement of the collection system was critical.

I explained that if we have a new RW or [redacted] in place at the new location we usually prefer to run parallel ops for a few day's prior to turning 1 off and the other on. The other scenario would mean dismantling [redacted] and re-installing it in the new location. I estimated about 2 weeks to complete either of these scenarios.

RW vs. [redacted]

I was asked which system did I prefer. I mentioned that both these collections systems are very reliable [redacted] believes the RW may be slightly better than the [redacted] in this application due to the high volume of collections activity). I was asked weather or not a minimal procurement of the core components would be possible from either vendors with the additional assets being provided through available on site components. I advised that I did not think either vendor would support that kind of procurement.

I was informed that ERF was already in negotiation [redacted] for a [redacted] collection system. I stressed the importance to verify that the quotes both provided the same installation and follow on support.

In order to set the record straight, the additional equipment mentioned at the very beginning of this message was NOT ADDITIONAL RW equip! It was a one-for-one replacement to an existing defective component. We (TICTU DCS-5000/ETMU) have a process in place that includes the field office, ETMU (facilities) [redacted] (Vendor), and TICTU DCS-5000. A phone survey is provided in advance to review the RW system and ALL pertinent information: i.e. power, BTUs, footprint, parts list, etc. This is necessary, in order to prepare the field office with the essential AC, power, space management, etc. Several communications follow up to ensure everything is in place, before actually performing the system installation.

This being said, glitches occur from time to time. We're working on improving these instances. If you continue to have concerns please let us know. We'd be happy to assist you.

Background

Digital Collection Program

Digital Collection supports the FBI's mission to ensure the ability of the FBI to collect evidence and intelligence through the acquisition, deployment, and support of communications interception techniques and systems to facilitate and support national security, domestic counterterrorism, and criminal investigative efforts. Systems being acquired under the Digital Collection program include systems (foreign counterintelligence and law enforcement) that possess similar functions and capabilities to intercept telephone, microphone, and facsimile communications.

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Background (continued)

Within the FBI, the TICTU is the primary technical support resource for the court-authorized interception of wireline and wireless communications. The Digital Collection Systems (DCSs) within the TICTU consist of the following three projects: DCS-3000, DCS-5000, and DCS-6000, which provide digital collection tools, foreign counterintelligence gathering, and law enforcement evidence collection, respectively.

Background (continued)

In late 1996, TIC/TU spearheaded the development of a unique telecommunications access program called the DCS-3000; an in-house system built to provide an interim solution to intercepts based on Communications Assistance to Law Enforcement Act (CALEA) inputs. This system was designed to interface with the switching facilities of wireless carriers that began deploying new digital technologies and offering diverse "Personal Communications Services." Since that time, the DCS-3000 has evolved into a viable interim solution, capable of interfacing with many models of wireline and wireless switches.

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Logistical Support Team

LST serves as the TICTU's technical advisors in matters regarding Bureau policies and procedures. Through this support, unit administrative efficiency is improved with the analysis of daily information requirements. The team develops and maintains the unit's strategic, program, and budgetary plans, while also improving problems of workflow, organization, planning, and technical assistance. LST also provides the property management function for the Unit. It serves as the central point of contact for the receiving, inventory, surplus, Engineering Research Facility storage, and distribution of TICTU equipment.
