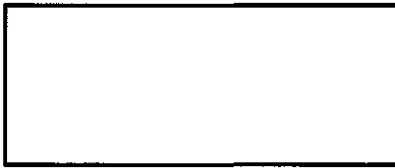

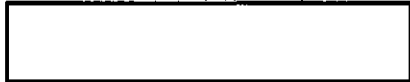

I just received a call from [redacted] I had previous telephone conversations with [redacted] regarding the ability of TICTU to start the procurement process of the RW II system since it appeared [redacted] was not going to be able to fund this project as quickly as originally thought. During the call today, [redacted] relayed that TICTU had available funds to order the RW II system for installation at [redacted] with the intention that [redacted] received the necessary funds, they would reimburse TICTU. [redacted] stated a formal MOU regarding the reimbursement was not necessary and asked that you enter an RMS to start the process.

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I am not sure exactly what you need for the RMS. I think you have all of the details for the justification, however a few points:

- The current [redacted] is on its last leg and at capacity.
- With the construction of [redacted] a new collection is necessary to handle the added capacity.
- We considered [redacted] however that system was not a viable option due to:
  - we require a system certified at least at the Secret level
  - [redacted] was not as reliable
  - [redacted] was more expensive
- The upgrade is required to ensure we maintain the collection ability required for [redacted]

I have been contacted by 3 sites that reported locked floppies. This is now the 4th. All of these sites, were sites that had yet had the security upgrade. The unrelated problems were corrected through other means.

The security upgrade going out should not be locking down floppies. If this is, then I will track this. There is a relatively easy cure. Those small number of workstations that will be affected will be handled on a case by case basis by the ERF.

I have just spoken with SSA [redacted]. He is unaware of any issues at this time. He did say that he would be contacting the Sysadmins to double-check the situation. I asked him to notify me if there truly were floppy issues.

I have just spoken with [redacted] (referenced below). This is correct, floppies will be locked after the next upgrade, not now. [redacted] is also unaware of any floppy lock issues at his site [redacted]

As many of you know, there has been a lot of discussion about on-line storage of audio and the overwrite procedure of the DCS 5000 RedWolf system. On-line storage was designed to provide access to audio while it is being processed - reviewed, translated, analyzed etc. It was never intended to be the permanent repository for collected audio - that role is filled by the archived MO. And with on-line storage capacity being a finite resource, and collection being a continuing process, it will at some time become necessary for the system to either overwrite collected audio - or stop collecting.
