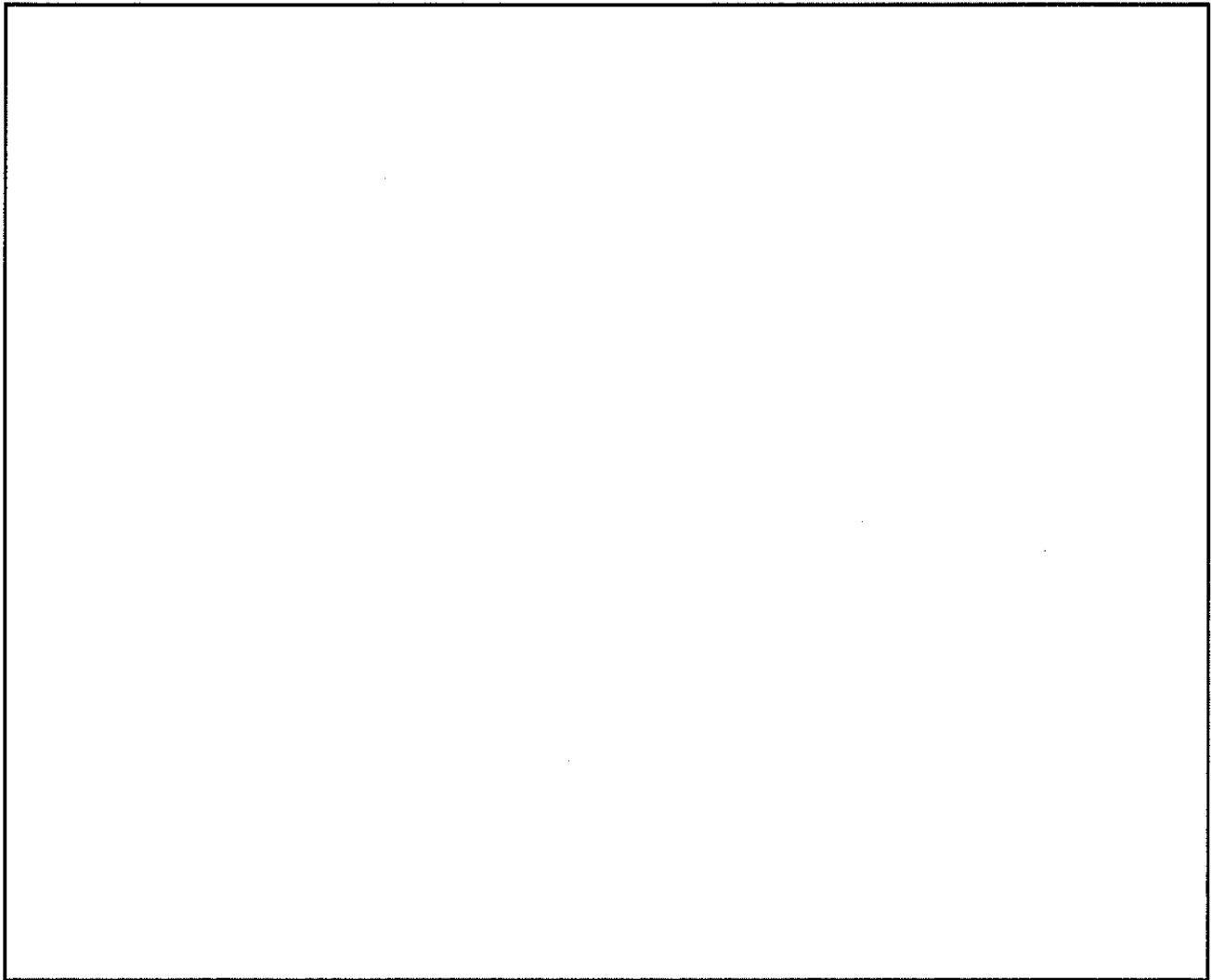

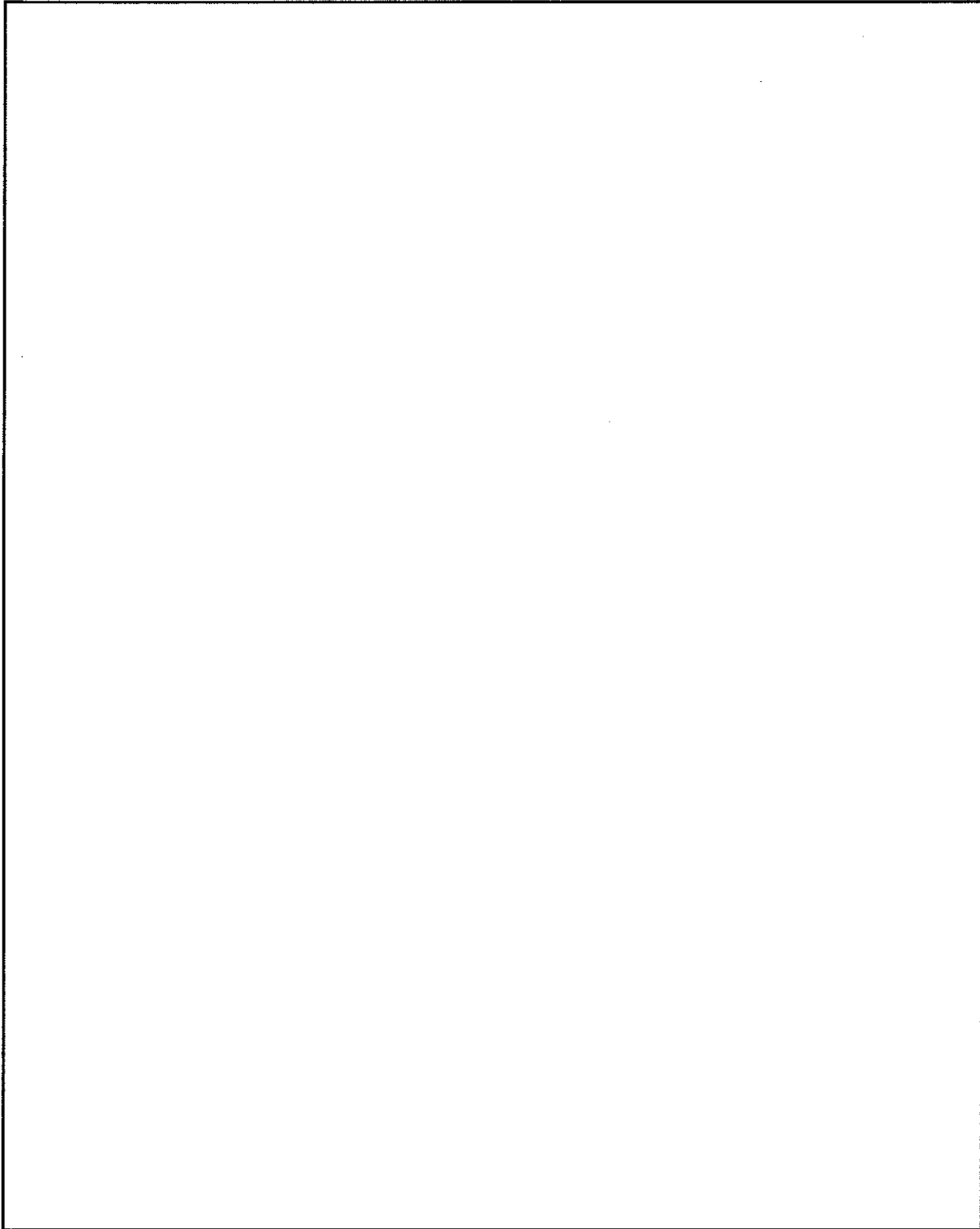

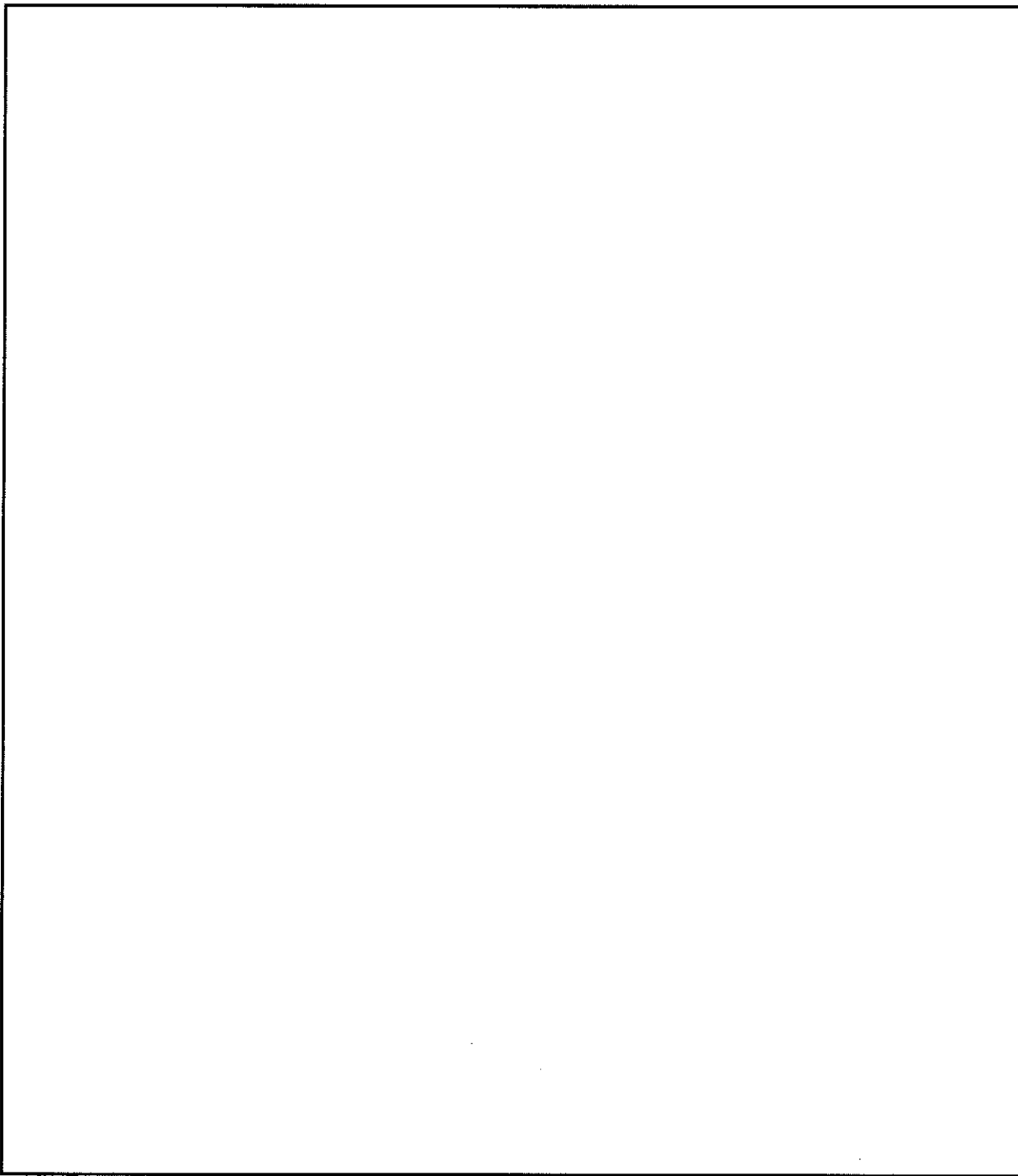

As you have just had an additional record server added to your configuration, and some other reconfiguration of your racks may have occurred during this reconfiguration, if you could send us a few digital photograph of the fronts and backs of each rack, we could get a better idea of what could fit in your rack without further rearrangement and also store the photos in the site file for future reference. I suspect that the additional power is related to the addition of the third record server or associated components?

You should have [redacted] in your system, one in each rack. Looking at the standard [redacted] configuration for a [redacted] (copy attached), it appears that there would be major rearrangement of your rack #2 components required to make another UPS (4U) fit in the rack. The UPS should be installed toward the bottom of the rack, and my configuration shows that the only place we could fit in a 4U UPS is over the [redacted] and that is not recommended.

I've attached a 'standard' configuration for the [redacted]. As your configuration already includes a [redacted] and [redacted] we should have a record of what your current configuration is for instances such as this one where you are requesting additional components to go into the rack.

Please indicate the deviations of your system from this configuration and either forward back to me, or fax a copy to [redacted]. The normal load on the two UPS units in a [redacted] to all components associated with the system including the [redacted].

The simple answer was that yes, the baseline is continually moving and it incorporates some of the development contract software as well as in house developed software.

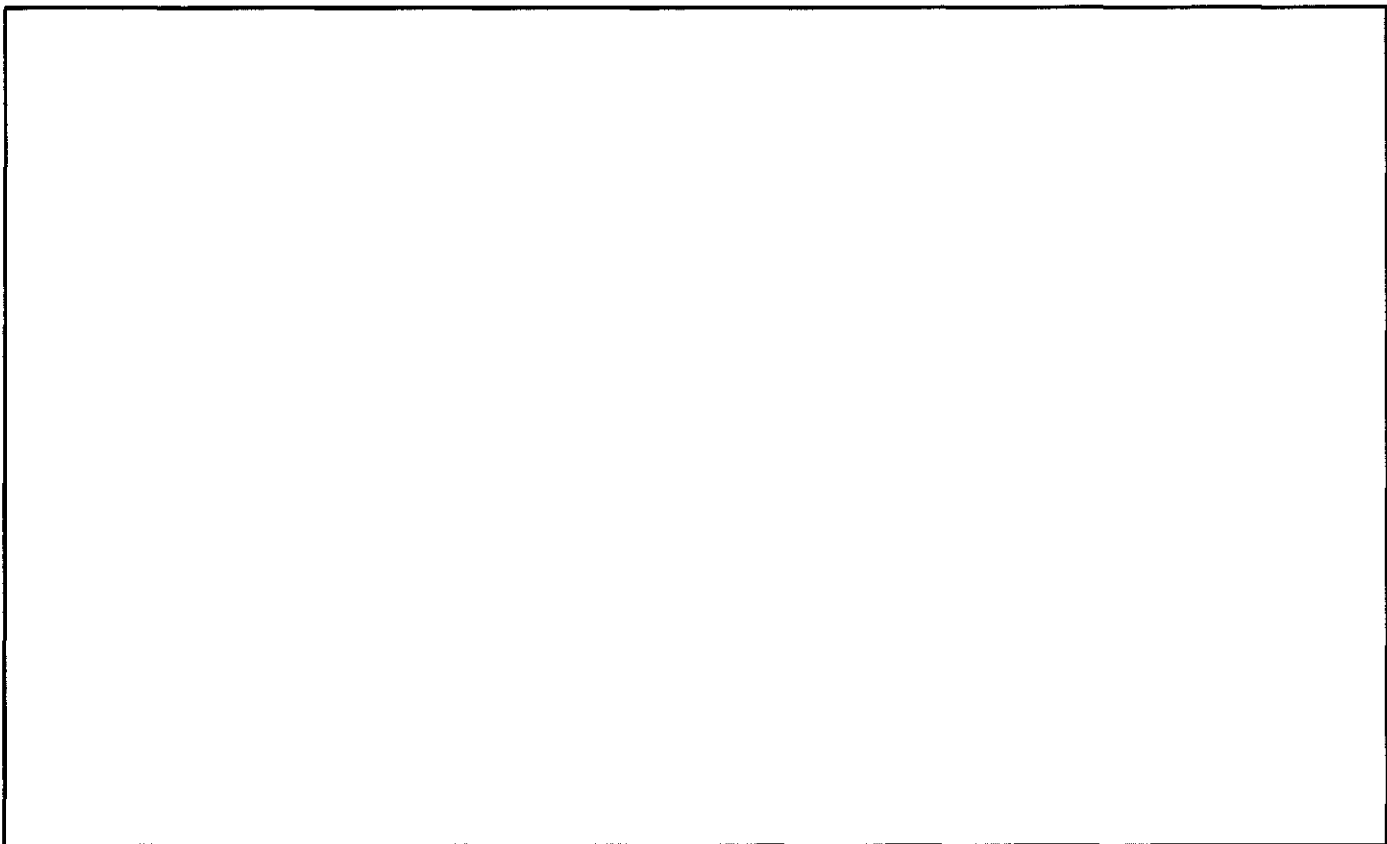
