- 3. Issuing or causing the issuance of legal threats to discourage or block the Internet hosting of links to the information contained in the Diebold email archive.

This Order to Show Cause and all supporting pleadings and papers must be served on Defendants not later than November 5, 2003, and proof of service shall be filed not later than November 7, 2003. Plaintiffs may file and serve supplemental briefing in support of their application for a preliminary injunction on or before November 7, 2003, and Defendants may file supplemental opposition on or before November 12, 2003. Plaintiffs may file a reply on or before November 14, 2003. In light of the accelerated briefing schedule set forth herein, Plaintiffs request for a temporary restraining order is DENIED.
