- 4. further and future entorcement, operation or execution of the statutes, regulations, rules, policies and practices declared unconstitutional under the Order of At just 25, 1997, including criminal or civil prosecutions, with respect to the Plaintiff for his use, discussion or publication of Snuffle 5.0/Unsnuffle 5.0 source code or Plaintiff's updated versions of Snuffle 5.0/Unsnuffle 5.0 source code designed to convert any one-way hash function into a zero-delay private key encryption system; and
- threatening, detaining, prosecuting, discouraging or otherwise interfering with Plaintiff in the exercise of his rights pursuant to the injunctive relief granted in paragraph at above; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED THAT if the defendants do not exercis: their right to appeal the Court's August 25, 1997 opinion and Order (and/or any modifications thereof) at whatever time such an appeal may be taken under the Federal Rules of Civil and Appellate Procedure, this stay shall expire by its own terms when defendants' decision is communicated to this Court and the Plaintiff, and the injunctive relief
