I refer to your letter dated February 22, 2008, requesting under the Freedom of Information Act (Title 5 USC Section 552) the release of certain records maintained by the Department of State concerning your client, Sophia Helena In 't Veld.

We initiated a search in the following record systems: the Bureau of Consular Affairs' Office of Visa Services, the American Embassy in Brussels, and the Central Foreign Policy Records (the principal centralized record system of the Department of State). The search in the Central Foreign Policy Records and the American Embassy in Brussels has been completed, resulting in the retrieval of no documents that were responsive to your request. The search of the active and retired records of the Office of Visa Services has also been completed, resulting in the retrieval of material that appears responsive to your request. The Office of Visa Services has reviewed this material and has provided you with review results in a separate letter from Mr. Jeffrey Gorsky.


The processing of this request has incurred no charges billable to you.
