Dear Fred:

I write to notify you that Apple Inc. is withdrawing its takedown notifications, issued to OdioWorks LLC in November, 2008 pursuant to the Digital Millennium Copyright Act ("DMCA"), regarding the "iTunesDB Pages" published on OdioWorks' BluWiki website.

As you know, Apple's objection about the "iTunesDB Pages" (as referenced in your complaint in this matter), sent to OdioWorks over seven months ago, centered on the publication of certain Apple code on those Pages. Since that time, Apple has stopped utilizing the code in question, rendering the code obsolete for the purposes at issue in this action. Publishing that code is no longer of any harm or benefit to anyone.

Given this change of circumstances, Apple no longer has, nor will it have in the future, any objection to the publication of the iTunesDB Pages which are the subject of the OdioWorks complaint. Apple therefore withdraws the notifications issued to OdioWorks under the DMCA regarding the iTunesDB Pages.

In light of Apple's withdrawal of the takedown notifications, there is no remaining live or potential controversy between Apple and OdioWorks. Accordingly, I will call you shortly to discuss how best to terminate OdioWorks' declaratory relief action.
